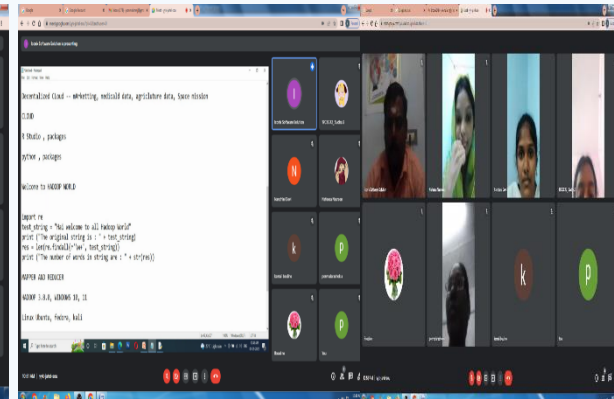
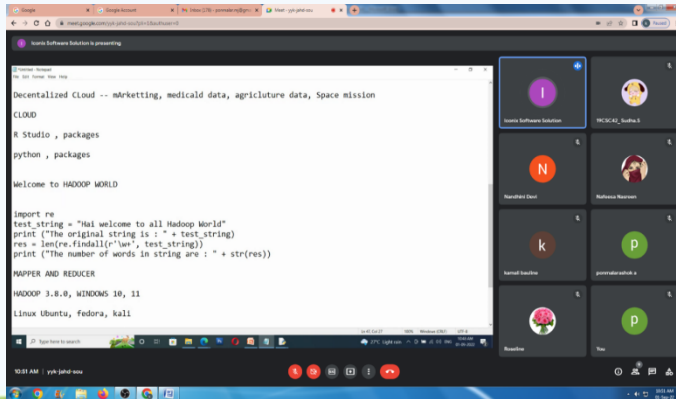
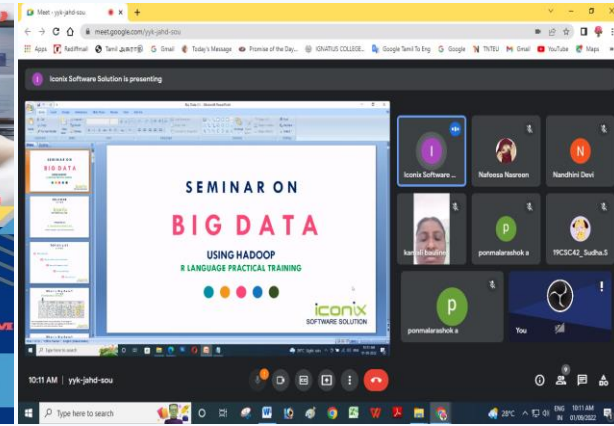
MEDICINAL PLANTS AND ITS CONSERVATION

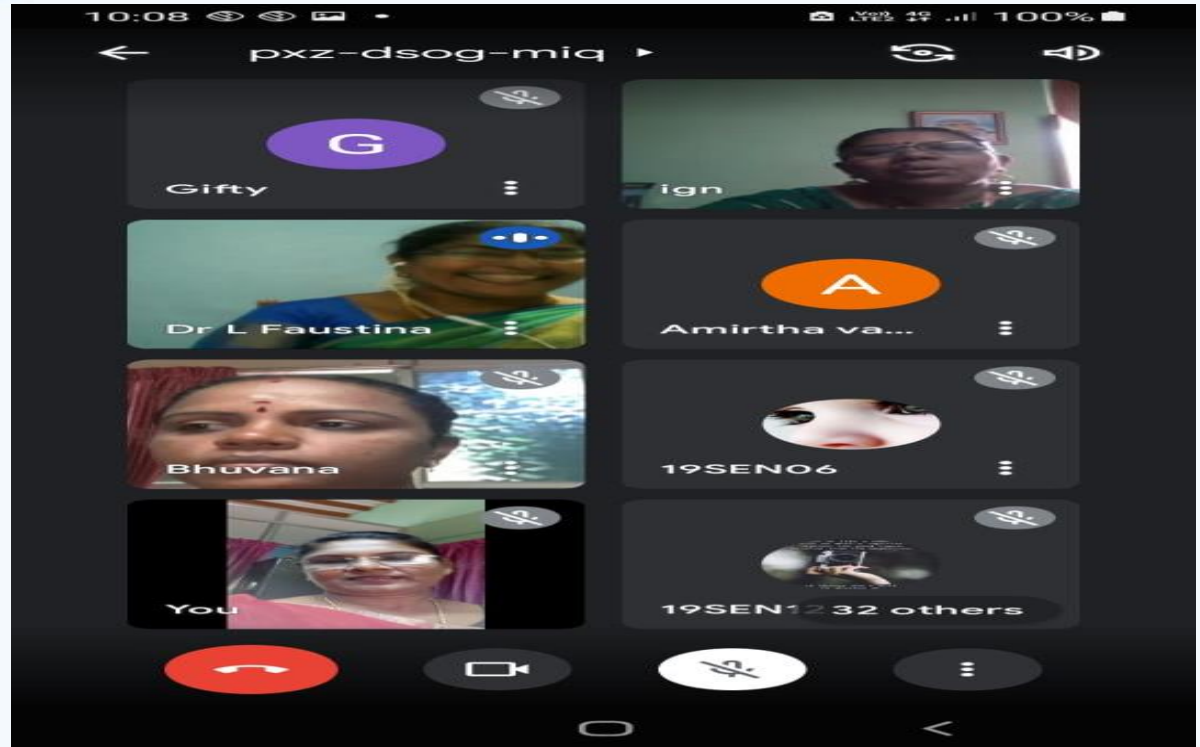
BIG DATA ANALYTICS

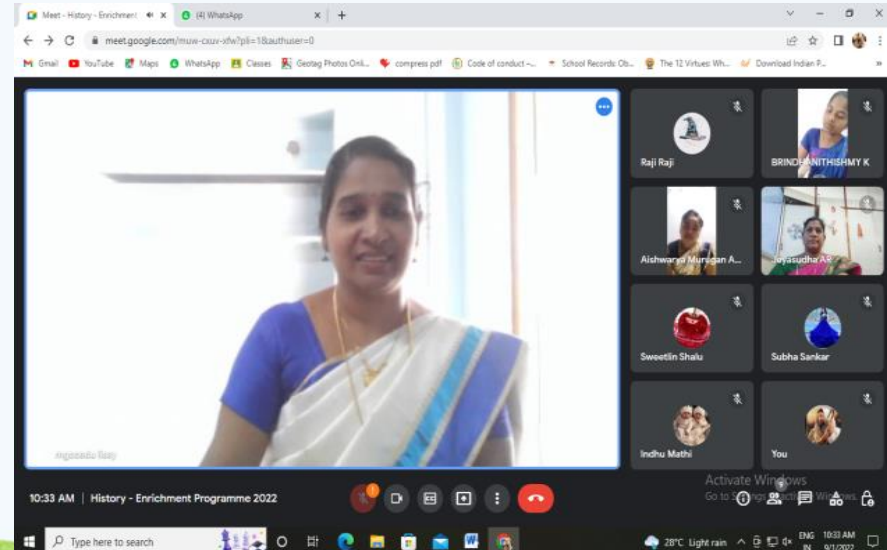
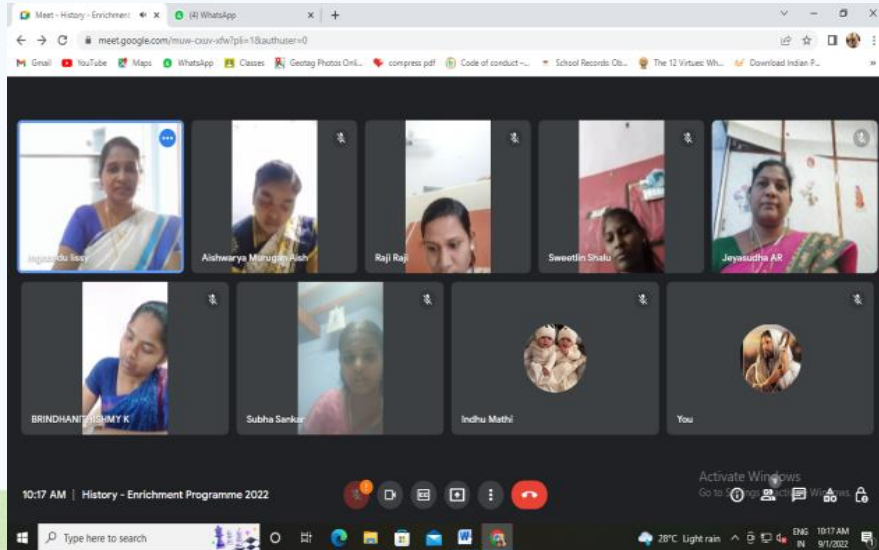
CHALLENGES IN TEACHING COMMUNICATIVE SKILLS FOR THE E-GENERATION LEARNERS



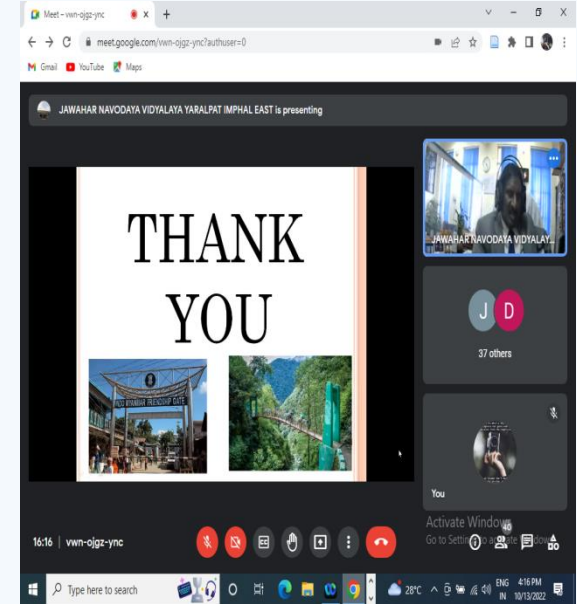
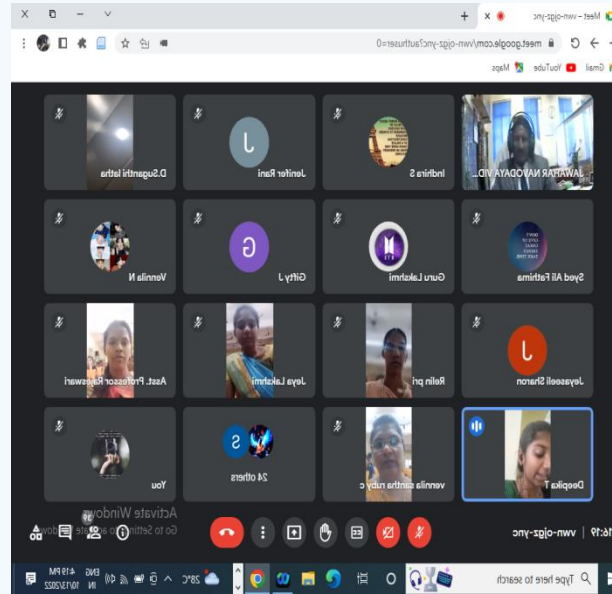
'Uyiroutamaana Tamil Vakupparaigal'.

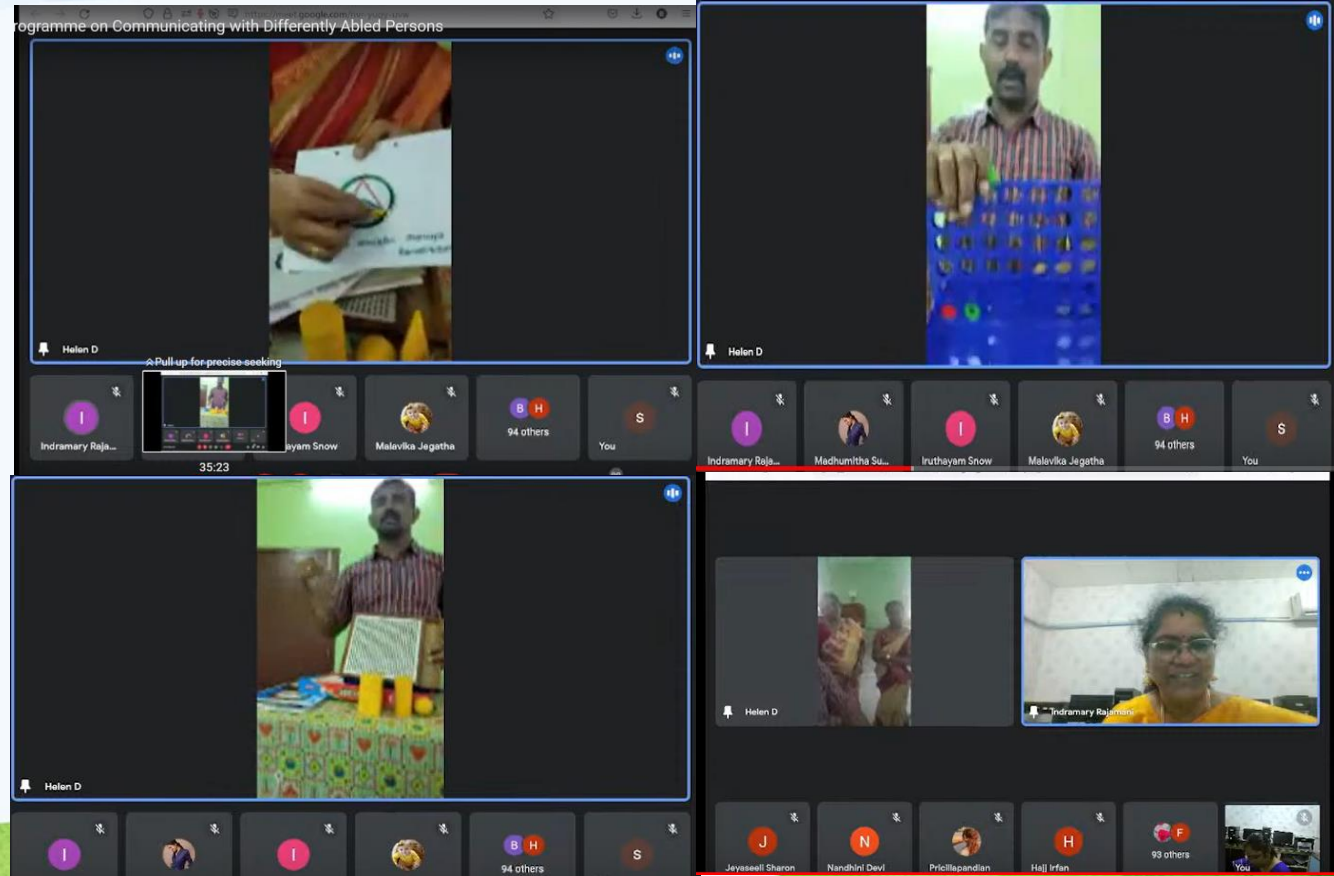
COMPARATIVE EDUCATIONAL PERSPECTIVE : STATE WISE VARIATION

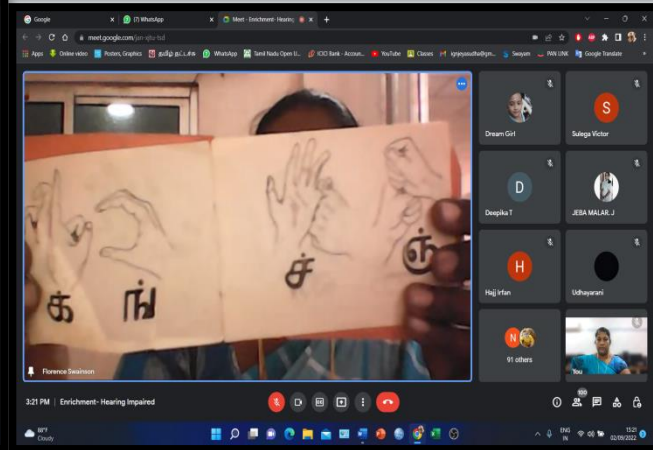
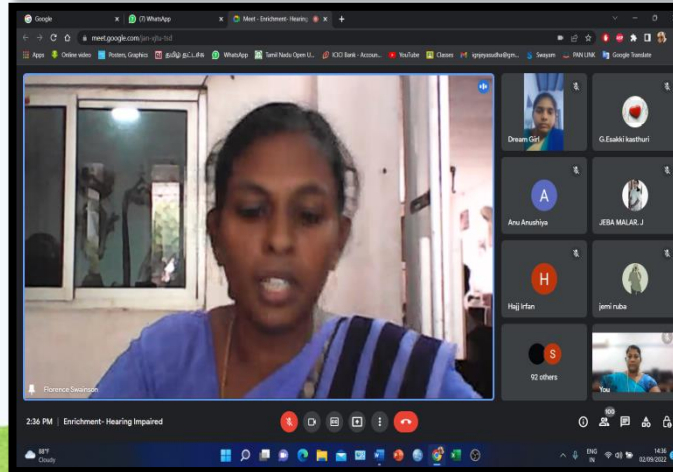
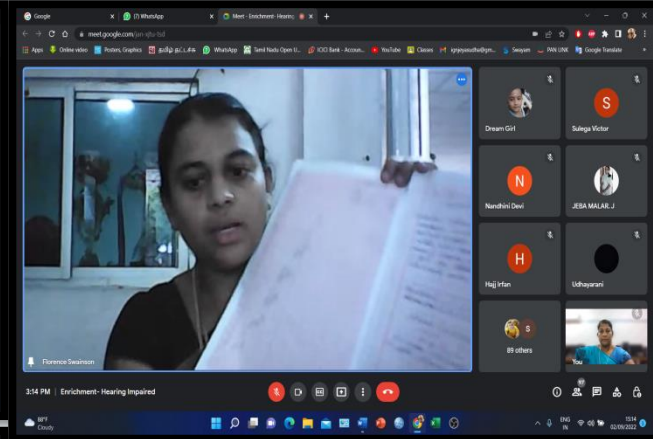
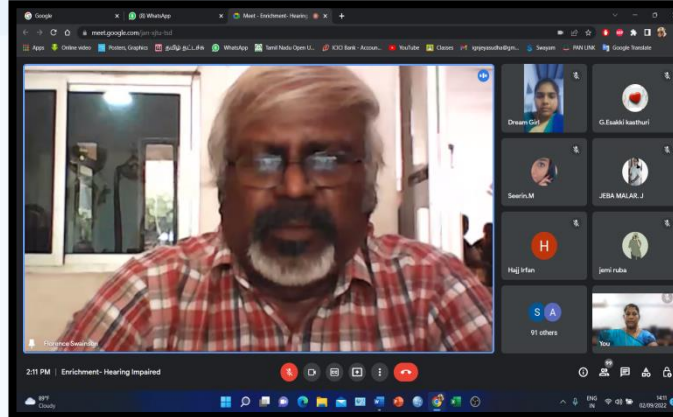
INSTRUCTIONAL TECHNIQUES FOR VISUALLY IMPAIRED CHILDREN

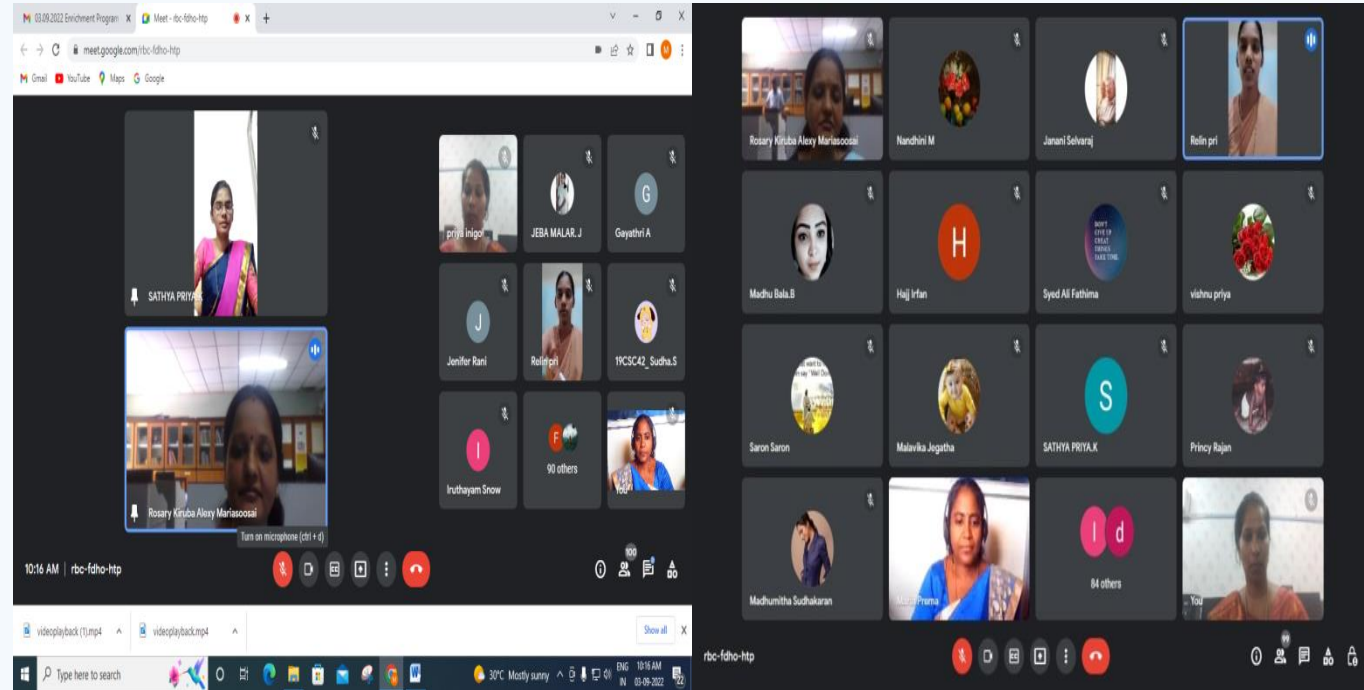
PEDAGOGY FOR STUDENTS WITH HEARING IMPAIRMENT
