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
CITIZENSHIP TRAINING CAMP

VILLAGE SURVEY, AWARENESS PROGRAMMES & ENTERPRENEURSHIP TRAINING UNDER UNNAT BHARATH ABIYAN

The Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) launched Unnat Bharat Ahiyaan (UBA) 2.0, which aims to bring a transformative change in rural development through the active participation of higher education institutes with rural communities and the reorientation of communities through research and development. It was launched in February 2018 by the Indian government. In June 2018, the University Grants Commission (UGC) established a Subject Expert Group (SEG) on Curricular Reforms and Educational Institutions Social Responsibility to help UBA 2.0 achieve its goals. Under UBA, St. Ignatius College of Education adopted five villages namely Melaputhaneri, Velankulam, Paraikulam, Pottalkulam and Uthamapandiyankulam and received the sum of 50,000 as seed money from Ministry of Education, Govt. of India. With this regard, prospective teachers along with the UBA committee members visited the villages and taken survey and conducted awareness programmes on "Water Conservation", "Importance of Education" and "Water Conservation", "Importance of Education" and "Ill Effects of Plastic waste", prospective teachers conducted Enterpreneurship Training on Making of Washing powder, Making of Silk Thread Jewellery, Making of Paper Bag, Making of Soap and Making of Omam Water to the village folk. One hundred and twenty people from the villages benifited from this workshops.
