III. Rules and Regulations of the Library

- Students should wear their ID cards, when entering the library
- Reference books can be referred inside the library only, if needed reprographic facility can be utilized
- Students can borrow books from the lending section of the library by using their ID card
- Each student can borrow two books for a period of one week
- Students should wrap the books borrowed by them to avoid damage
- Books must be returned on or before the prescribed due date
- Loss or damage of any books should be immediately reported to the Librarian
- Students in need can avail the facility of book bank to borrow books with the recommendation of their optional subject staff
- Students can access and download e-books and e-journals by using their User ID and Password
